The pharmaceuticals were mixed in bags, no labels, similar to what occurs at "pharm parties."</p> <p>Fred U. from HS: Helping to organize the Youth Worker Coalition Conference, April 21 at Liberty Hall in Kimberly.</p> <p>Dorry W. from OPD: Oshkosh PD received a CARDS (alcohol compliance checks) grant again this year.</p> <p>Scott R. from WCSO: Alcohol compliance checks training for all county law enforcement agencies to develop a similar way to conduct checks utilizing skills and experience of WCSO and OPD.</p> <p>Doug G from WCHD: County Board voted Tuesday the 19th to grant the Winnebago County Sheriff's Dept citation authority for underage tobacco possession. Effective Mar 1</p> <p>Lisa B from re:TH!NK: There was a hearing on Jan 20 for AB227, bill to create a statewide PDMP (Prescription Drug Monitoring Program). Two re:TH!NK partners educated the committee. <p>Coalition Structure and Reorganization</p>	<p>Draft of Partner Levels, Committees/Workgroups and a new way to list our Objectives was proposed. Items currently vary in level of development. Purpose for presenting these draft ideas is to gain feedback from the entire coalition AND update everyone on its progress.</p> <p>Partners: "Participating" has several meanings with a lot of opportunities. Tobacco Prevention and Control: MJs	<p>Why a Multi-Jurisdictional Coalition?: Budget Cuts, shift in focus of tobacco prevention and control objectives.</p> <p>New Winnebago MJC includes Door, Kewaunee, Manitowoc and Sheboygan Co. Contract is for 1-year but potential for up to 5-years. Tobacco goals, objectives and activities will be shared by all counties in the MJC.
